COMPETITIONS:

- Best Brace – One owner can enter his/her dog and bitch of the same breed that have been judged at this show
- Best kennel – A breeder can enter his/her breeder's group of at least three dogs or bitches of the same breed, color and size, which have been judged at this show. The dogs/bitches do not have to be owned by the breeder, but they must come from the same kennel from at least two different litters, at least two different sires or dams. A dog/bitch can only be entered to one breeder's group. Exhibitors are obliged to let their dogs compete in this competition when asked by the breeder.

ENTRY FEES

Every additional dog of the same owner	18,- EUR
Minor Puppy, Puppy, Veteran class	10,- EUR
Competitions	10,- EUR
Honour Class	Free of charge

When entering more than one dog, the MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY or VETERAN cannot be considered as the first dog)

ALL PAYMENTS FROM FOREIGN EXHIBITORS WILL BE ACCEPTED IN CASH ONLY ON THE DAY.

Payment could be made in EUR or CZK only.

WE ARE TRULY SORRY BUT WE CANNOT ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS AND PERSONAL CHEQUES.

VETERINARY CONDITIONS:

- All the entered dogs must be clinically healthy.
- Dogs must have pet passport or veterinary certificate with valid vaccination against rabies.
- Dogs from EU and third countries must have valid EU Pet Passport and must meet the
- conditions by the EU Regulation 998/2003 from 26/5/2003
- All the time during the dog show the owners must supervise / take care of the dogs so that
- they do not cause any damage to other dogs or humans

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

The dog show is organized according to the dog show rules of the FCI and ČMKU and LOWCHEN CLUB CZ. Only dogs entered in FCI-accepted studbooks are allowed to take part at the show. Certain dogs have to reach the age required for entering the desired class on the show day at the latest. Division into classes is according by the

FCI Show Regulation and is described in the registration form. In case there is no copy of a certificate approving the fulfillment of the conditions for entering champion class is attached to the entry form, the dog will be put into open class. The organizer of the show is not responsible for any damages caused by the dog or by the exhibitor neither for death nor for loss of the dog. Dogs with cropped ears are not allowed into the show grounds and will not be judged. Changes in exterior of a dog performed by means of excessive use of lacquer, powder, hair tinting and basic trimming connected with a long-time tying-up of the dog on a table are forbidden at the show. The violation of these rules can lead to disqualification of the dog. The exhibitors are obliged to abide with the provisions of the FCI Show Regulations, of these propositions and the instructions of the Show Committee, to which they bind themselves by submitting the entry form. They are also obliged to maintain the exhibition area clean. In case the show does not take place for objective reasons, the fees would be used for covering the show preparation expenses. It is forbidden to bring puppies for the purpose of sale to the show. The organizer does not accept any responsibility for undelivered applications.

Documents submitted after entry deadline will not be taken into consideration.

PROTESTS:

- A protest against any decision made by the judge is not admissible.
- A protest can be submitted for formal reasons such as violation of show regulation provisions and proposition provisions.
- The protest must be submitted in written form, against a deposit of 50 Euro, during the course of the show.
- If the protest is found to be unjustified, this deposit will be forfeited to the organizer of the show.

IMPORTANT ADVICE:

Entry forms should be filled out using a typewriter or in block letters. For each dog, a separate entry form should be filled out. Illegible applications will not be accepted. The discount for the second and additional dogs may be applied only if the name of the owner is the same as for the first dog. Any change in the second entry form, e.g. addition of joint ownership, will be considered to be a new entry at full cost. The organizer does not accept any responsibility for an incorrectly filled-in entry forms. A copy of the pedigree must be attached to each application form. In the case of an imported dog, the abbreviation of the original studbook and the original registration number must be written in the entry form as well. A dog can only be entered into one class. Moving dogs between classes is not possible after the deadline. Accepting of the entry form will be confirmed 10 days before the show (by e-mail).
